Added Amino Acids with Guaranteed Lysine - *Helps ensure quality protein is available for proper growth and development of muscle tissue.*

Guaranteed Levels of Calcium and Phosphorus - *Helps ensure proper calcium to phosphorus ratio for bone growth and development in foals and for milk composition in lactating mares..*

Chelated Zinc, Copper and Manganese, Plus Bio-Available Selenium - *The greater mineral absorption and utilization helps meet the increased needs for bone, muscle and tissue strength in growing horses. Proper mineral nutrition can help guard against developmental orthopedic diseases in foals through direct consumption or indirectly through mare's milk.*

Vitamins A, D and E - *Provides a supplemental source to guard against deficiencies and maintain optimal health and metabolism. A high level of vitamin E minimizes the effects of stress on the rapidly growing foal and performance horse.*

Yeast Culture - *Sustains a healthy microbial fermentation in the horse cecum and colon, supporting efficient nutrient digestibility and subsequent mare milk composition, foal growth, and horse performance.*

Suggested Feeding Recommendations:

Daily Guide: Adjust the feeding program according to the condition of the horse. Provide horses with good-quality hay, free-choice salt and plenty of fresh water.

Light Work (1 - 3 hrs/day)	Mature	
Moderate Work (3 - 5 hrs/day)	Mature	
Intense Work (5 - 8 hrs/day)	Mature	
Pregnant Mare (last 3 months)	Mature	0.50 - 0.75
Lactating Mare	Mature	1.00 - 1.75
Breeding Stallion	Mature	0.50 - 0.75
