Demand[®] is A high-fat, high-protein, pelleted grain ration containing a moderate level of fiber for young growing horses and starch or glycogen sensitive horses. **Demand[®]** contains a high nutritional profile and offers an optimum balance of energy and fiber for safe grain feeding.

Available in a 50-lb bag.

Features and Benefits

Pelleted Form - *Pelleting improves the digestibility and nutrient utilization of grains in the horses' sensitive digestive tract, while providing balanced nutrition in every bite.*

High Fat (6.5%) - *Vegetable Oil increases energy density and efficiency. The addition of fat helps reduce the risk of starch overload while maintaining desired calorie level for optimum weight and body condition of active horses.*

Low Starch/No Corn - *Demand[®] is formulated without corn or other high-starch ingredients. It contains a low non-fiber carbohydrate level for horses sensitive to readily available sugars and starch. A low sugar and starch diet may also help minimize developmental orthopedic diseases in growing foals.*

Fermentable Fiber - *Promotes healthy digestive function and provides calories without the risks associated with high-starch feeding.*

Added Amino Acids with Guaranteed Lysine and Methionine - *Helps ensure quality protein is available for proper growth and development of muscle tissue. Methionine is essential for good health and condition of hooves and hair coat.*

Chelated Zinc, Copper and Manganese, Plus Bio-Available Selenium - *The greater mineral absorption and utilization helps meet the increased needs for bone, muscle and tissue strength in growing horses. Proper mineral nutrition can help guard against developmental orthopedic diseases in foals through direct consumption or indirectly through mare's milk.*

Vitamins A, D, E, and Stable Vitamin C - *Provides a supplemental source to help guard against deficiencies and maintain optimal health. As potent antioxidants, vitamins E and C help maintain cell membrane*

Suggested Feeding Recommendations:

Daily Guide: Adjust the feeding program according to the condition of the horse. Provide horses with good-quality hay, free-choice salt and plenty of fresh water.
